### **Day 01 Giraffe Centre**

#### **Giraffe Centre**

The Giraffe Centre, run by the African Fund for Endangered Wildlife, is primarily known for conserving the endangered Rothschild giraffe. Visitors can interact with the giraffes by feeding them from elevated platforms, offering an up-close experience with these majestic creatures. There are educational talks about giraffes and conservation efforts. The Centre is surrounded by a beautiful nature trail, perfect for a short walk through indigenous forest.

#### **Karen Blixen Museum**

The Karen Blixen Museum, located at the former home of Danish author Karen Blixen, is a historic site dedicated to her life and work. Blixen is best known for her memoir "Out of Africa", which was later adapted into an Oscar-winning film. The museum provides insight into colonial life in Kenya, Blixen's experiences, and her contributions to literature. The house is preserved as it was when Blixen lived there, with original furniture, manuscripts, and artifacts.
