Tour Plan

Day 01 **Arrival in Maun, Botswana**

- Arrival Airport: Maun International Airport (MUB)
- Activities:
 - Airport pickup and transfer to your lodge in Maun.
 - Safari briefing and discussion of itinerary with your guide.
 - Optional short scenic flight over the Okavango Delta (additional cost).
- Accommodation: Luxury lodge in Maun.
- Highlight: Introduction to Botswana and preparation for safari adventure.

Day 02 - Day 04 **Savuti, Chobe National Park**

- Travel: Light aircraft transfer or 4x4 safari vehicle to Savuti.
- Activities:
 - Morning and afternoon game drives in Savuti, known for its large predator populations.
 - Wildlife sightings: lions, cheetahs, hyenas, elephants, zebras, and African wild dogs.
 - Optional bush walks and photography sessions in open savannah landscapes.
 - Explore the Savuti Marsh for spectacular sunset views over the plains.
- Accommodation: Luxury tented camp or safari lodge in Savuti.



- Highlight: Big cats, predator-rich ecosystem, and dramatic African landscapes.

Day 05 - Day 07 **Chobe Riverfront**

- Travel: Drive or light aircraft transfer to Chobe Riverfront.
- Activities:
 - Game drives along the riverfront, famous for massive elephant herds.
 - Boat safari on Chobe River to spot hippos, crocodiles, and abundant birdlife.
 - Optional sunset cruise with champagne and wildlife photography.
 - Visit local villages or cultural sites along the river (optional).
- Accommodation: Luxury lodge or tented camp along Chobe River.
- Highlight: Close encounters with elephants and dramatic river sunsets.

Day 08 - Day 10 **Okavango Delta**

- Travel: Light aircraft transfer or 4x4 drive into the Delta.
- Activities:
 - Explore the delta via mokoro (dugout canoe) trips and motorboat safaris.
 - Walking safaris led by expert guides to discover smaller wildlife, birdlife, and unique flora.
 - Game drives on the delta islands and floodplains.
 - Optional photography workshops or night safaris for nocturnal wildlife.
- Accommodation: Luxury tented camp on an island in the Okavango Delta.



- Highlight: Pristine waterways, intimate wildlife encounters, and serene delta landscapes.
