- **Swakopmund Coastal Town:** Discover the German colonial architecture, lively cafés, and craft markets. Optional activities include sandboarding, quad biking, scenic flights, or skydiving along the Atlantic coast.
- **Damaraland:** Explore the rugged wilderness, spot desert-adapted elephants, and visit the ancient rock engravings at Twyfelfontein, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Experience Namibia's unique landscapes of volcanic hills, dry riverbeds, and quiver tree forests.
- **Etosha National Park:** Game drive in one of Africa's most famous wildlife reserves. Observe elephants, lions, leopards, rhinos, and abundant antelope species, especially at the park's scenic waterholes. **Authentic Safari Experience:** Accommodation combines budget lodges, standard lodges, or campsites, providing an immersive experience of Namibia's wilderness without compromising comfort.

Tour Plan

Day 01 Windhoek

Arrive in Windhoek, the capital of Namibia. Spend the day exploring the city's colonial architecture, museums, and craft markets. In the evening, enjoy dinner at one of the city's many restaurants.

Day 02 Sossusvlei

Drive to Sossusvlei, a stunning desert landscape of towering sand dunes. Spend the day exploring the dunes and taking in the incredible views. Overnight at a lodge near Sossusvlei.

Day 03 Swakopmund

Drive to the coastal town of Swakopmund. En route, stop at the quirky town of Solitaire for lunch. In Swakopmund, enjoy the town's German-influenced architecture, seaside



promenade, and adventure activities like sandboarding and skydiving. Overnight in Swakopmund.

Day 04 **Skeleton Coast**

Drive along the Skeleton Coast, a desolate and beautiful coastline that's home to shipwrecks, seal colonies, and unique flora and fauna. Visit the Cape Cross seal colony and stop at the historic town of Henties Bay. Overnight in a lodge along the Skeleton Coast.

Day 05 **Etosha National Park**

Drive to Etosha National Park, one of Africa's premier wildlife reserves. Spend the day on a game drive, watching for elephants, lions, giraffes, and other animals. Overnight at a lodge in or near the park.

Day 06 **Etosha National Park**

Spend another day on a game drive in Etosha National Park. Overnight at a lodge in or near the park.

Day 07 **Damaraland**

Drive to Damaraland, a rugged and beautiful landscape that's home to ancient rock art, desert-adapted elephants, and the highest mountain in Namibia, the Brandberg. Visit the rock art sites and spend the night at a lodge in Damaraland.

Day 08 **Windhoek**

Drive back to Windhoek, stopping en route for lunch. Spend the day shopping for souvenirs and enjoying a final dinner in Namibia before departing the next day.
