Tour Plan

Day 01 Travel Day – Depart for Madrid

Board your overnight international flight to Madrid, Spain's capital. Relax and prepare for an adventure filled with culture, cuisine, and history.

Madrid — 3 Nights

Day 02 Arrival in Madrid

Arrive in Madrid, a city where royal tradition meets modern sophistication. Meet your Tour Director and fellow travelers for a welcome briefing. In the evening, enjoy a welcome dinner with wine, featuring classic Spanish dishes such as tortilla española and jamón ibérico.

Overnight in central Madrid.

Day 03 Madrid City Tour



Begin your morning with a guided sightseeing tour of Spain's bustling capital:

- Royal Palace: The official residence of the Spanish monarchy, an architectural masterpiece of baroque elegance.
- Prado Museum: Home to timeless works by Goya, Velázquez, and El Greco.
- Temple of Debod: An ancient Egyptian temple gifted to Spain.
- Plaza Mayor and Plaza de Neptuno: Madrid's iconic squares, perfect for people-watching and coffee sipping.

Optional Experience: Traditional Spanish Evening – Enjoy an atmospheric night featuring dinner, live tuna music, and dancing. *(From \$165 CAD)*

Day 04 Free Day or Toledo Excursion

Spend the day exploring Madrid's elegant boulevards or join an optional excursion to Toledo, a UNESCO World Heritage city where Christian, Muslim, and Jewish influences converge. Visit the Toledo Cathedral and view El Greco's masterpieces. *Optional Excursion: From \$145 CAD*

Seville — 2 Nights

Day 05 Journey to Seville via Córdoba

Depart for Seville with a stop in Córdoba, once the heart of Moorish Spain.



- Tour the Mezquita-Catedral, a mesmerizing mosque-cathedral blending Islamic and Christian architecture.
- Visit a traditional olive oil estate for a tasting and behind-the-scenes look at Spain's "liquid gold." Arrive in Seville and enjoy a delicious included dinner at a local restaurant.

Day 06 Exploring Seville

Seville captivates with its romance, color, and Andalusian rhythm.

- See the Plaza de España, a stunning landmark built for the 1929 Ibero-American Exposition.
- Wander through the Barrio de Santa Cruz, a maze of narrow lanes and whitewashed courtyards.
- Visit Seville Cathedral, the largest Gothic church in the world, and La Giralda Tower for panoramic views.

Optional Experience: Flamenco Show – Immerse yourself in Andalusia's soul with a passionate performance of dance, guitar, and song. (From \$109 CAD)

Costa del Sol — 2 Nights

Day 07 En Route via Ronda

Travel through scenic mountain roads to Ronda, one of Spain's oldest towns perched dramatically atop a gorge.



- Visit Puente Nuevo Bridge, an 18th-century marvel spanning the deep El Tajo canyon.
- Explore Casa Don Bosco, a charming modernist villa with breathtaking views. Arrive at the Costa del Sol, known for its Mediterranean beauty, golden beaches, and coastal resorts. Enjoy an included dinner and overnight stay.

Day 08 Free Day at Costa del Sol

Relax by the sea, shop in local markets, or join an optional full-day excursion to Gibraltar, where you'll see the famous Rock and interact with the playful Barbary macaques. *(From \$219 CAD)* Spend the evening enjoying fresh seafood or a sunset stroll along the promenade.

Granada — 1 Night

Day 09 The Alhambra & Generalife Gardens

Depart for Granada, a jewel of Moorish Spain.

- Visit the Alhambra Palace, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and architectural masterpiece of Islamic art.
- Stroll through the Generalife Gardens, once the summer retreat of Nasrid kings.
- Explore the ornate Nasrid Palaces, filled with delicate carvings and tranquil courtyards. Enjoy an included dinner at a local restaurant overlooking the city's historic skyline.

Valencia — 2 Nights



Day 10 Via Guadix

Travel east, stopping in Guadix, a unique town known for its cave dwellings carved into the hillsides — homes that have been continuously inhabited for centuries. Continue to the coastal city of Valencia.

Day 11 Valencia City Tour

Discover Valencia's blend of history and innovation:

- Visit the futuristic City of Arts and Sciences, designed by Santiago Calatrava.
- Tour the Lonja de la Seda (Silk Exchange), a UNESCO-listed Gothic masterpiece.
- Taste authentic horchata, a sweet drink made from tiger nuts.

In the evening, enjoy free time to sample paella, Valencia's most famous dish, or walk through the scenic Turia Gardens, once a riverbed turned into an urban park.

Barcelona — 2 Nights

Day 12 Scenic Coastal Drive to Barcelona

Travel north along the glittering Mediterranean coast to Barcelona, Catalonia's vibrant capital, known for its modernist architecture and seaside energy.

Day 13 Barcelona City Tour



Explore one of Europe's most creative cities:

- Visit La Sagrada Familia, Antoni Gaudí's still-unfinished masterpiece and a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- Drive along Passeig de Gracia, lined with Gaudí's architectural wonders like Casa Batlló and Casa Milà (La Pedrera).
- Visit Montjuïc Hill for panoramic city and harbor views.

Optional Experience: Park Güell & La Pedrera – Discover Gaudí's whimsical park and explore one of his most iconic apartment buildings. (From \$159 CAD)

In the evening, join your group for a farewell dinner to celebrate your Spanish adventure.

Day 14 Departure

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight home. (*Note: early departures may not include breakfast.*)

Optional Barcelona Extension 2 Nights

Day 14: Free Day in Barcelona

Enjoy an extra day to explore the city at your own pace, or join an optional Picasso & Gothic Quarter Tour to see the artist's early works and walk through the medieval streets of Barri Gòtic. (*From \$129 CAD*)



Day 15: Montserrat Excursion or Leisure

Take an optional excursion to Montserrat Abbey, a Benedictine monastery nestled high in the mountains, accessible by cable car. Enjoy stunning Pyrenean views and free time to explore. *(From \$149 CAD)* Later, toast your journey with a farewell drink among your fellow travelers.

Day 16: Departure

Transfer to the airport for your return flight home.
