# Tour Plan

## Day 01 Arrival in Nairobi

Arrive at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport where you'll be greeted by your safari guide. Transfer to your Nairobi hotel for check-in. Depending on arrival time, you may explore Nairobi's highlights:

- Visit the David Sheldrick Elephant Orphanage to see rescued baby elephants.
- Discover the Giraffe Centre, home to endangered Rothschild's giraffes.
- Enjoy a welcome dinner at the iconic Carnivore Restaurant or relax at your lodge. Overnight in Nairobi.

## Day 02 - 04 Masai Mara National Reserve

Journey through the Great Rift Valley to the legendary Masai Mara, Kenya's premier wildlife reserve.

Highlights:

- Game drives across golden plains, famous for dense predator populations.
- Spotting the Big Five alongside cheetahs, giraffes, and countless antelopes.
- Seasonal spectacle of the Great Wildebeest Migration (July–October).
- Optional hot-air balloon safari at sunrise followed by champagne breakfast.
- Evening visits to a Maasai village to learn about traditional lifestyles.

### **Day 05** Lake Naivasha & Crescent Island

Drive to Lake Naivasha, a freshwater lake fringed with papyrus and acacia woodland.

Experiences:

- Boat ride to see hippos, kingfishers, and African fish eagles swooping for prey.
- Guided walking safari on Crescent Island, where giraffes, zebras, and wildebeests roam without predators.
- Optional visit to Hell's Gate National Park for cycling or hiking through dramatic gorges.

### **Day 06** Amboseli National Park

Travel south to Amboseli, famous for its large elephant herds and panoramic views of Mount Kilimanjaro.

Highlights:

- Game drives to spot lions, cheetahs, buffalo, hyenas, and flamingos at Amboseli's swamps.
- Iconic photography opportunities with elephants silhouetted against Kilimanjaro.



- Visit to a Maasai homestead for cultural insight.

Overnight in Amboseli safari lodge/camp.

### **Day 07 - 08 Tsavo West & Tsavo East National Parks**

Continue to Tsavo, Kenya's largest park, divided into West and East.

Tsavo West:

- Explore the lush Mzima Springs, home to hippos and crocodiles.
- Visit the Shetani Lava Flows, remnants of ancient volcanic activity.
- Track endangered black rhinos at the Ngulia Rhino Sanctuary.

Tsavo East:

- Famous for "red elephants" dusted with the park's rich red soil.
- Vast open plains offering sightings of lions, giraffes, hartebeests, and birdlife.
- Visit Aruba Dam, a great wildlife viewing spot.

Overnight in lodges or camps within Tsavo.

### **Day 09 - 13 Indian Ocean Beach Escape (Diani / Watamu / Mombasa**

After days of safari excitement, transfer to the coast for relaxation on Kenya's world-class beaches. Choose between Diani (south coast), Watamu (north coast), or Mombasa Island resorts.



## Beach Experiences:

- Unwind on white sandy beaches and swim in turquoise waters.
- Go snorkeling or diving at coral reefs in Kisite-Mpunguti or Watamu Marine Parks.
- Take a traditional dhow cruise at sunset with seafood dinner.
- Visit Wasini Island for dolphin spotting and Swahili coastal cuisine.
- Optional excursions to Fort Jesus (UNESCO site) in Mombasa or Arabuko Sokoke Forest near Watamu.
- Enjoy water sports—kite surfing, paddleboarding, deep-sea fishing.
- Evenings filled with starlit skies, Swahili dishes, and vibrant nightlife in coastal towns.

Overnight at luxury beach resorts, boutique villas, or family-friendly hotels.

## Day 14 Departure

Spend the morning at leisure, soaking up your final moments by the sea. Transfer to Moi International Airport (Mombasa) or Nairobi for your international flight home.
